

2024 The Little One

Gönc Winery | Štajerska, Slovenia



The Little One is a crisp white wine from Štajerska, Slovenia. Winemaker Peter Gönc created this blend of Pinot Blanc and Yellow Muscat to deliver gorgeous aroma and bright acidity. This is a great example of what the region's marl and sandstone soils can deliver. Fresh, approachable wines with lots of character.

TERROIR

Located in the Štajerska, Slovenia, the southeast facing vineyards sit at 305 meters elevation. 35 year old vines grown in soils rich in marl and sandstone. These mineral rich soils provide structure and minerality.

WINEMAKING

Harvested in September. Fermentation takes place in stainless steel over 14 days at 60.8°F. The wine is aged for 6 months in stainless steel, followed by 2 months of bottle aging before release.

TASTING NOTES	Fresh and crisp with lively aromatics. Bright fruit character supported by clean acidity and a focused, refreshing finish.
