

# Domaine Beauséjour

Touraine | Loire Valley, France

Fresh, fruit-driven wines of the Loire | Sustainable farming, early-drinking appeal

Domaine Beauséjour is a 20-hectare estate in Touraine, located along the slopes of the Cher River across Noyers-sur-Cher and Saint-Romain-sur-Cher. Cultivated for five generations by the Trotignon family, the domaine entered a new chapter in 2022 when it was acquired by Arnaud and Sibylle Lechat.

Today, the estate is guided with a focus on continuity, quality, and respect for its natural rhythm. With sustainable farming, a balance of traditional and modern cellar practices, and a style centered on freshness and accessibility, Domaine Beauséjour produces wines that clearly express the charm of Touraine.



## The Estate

Located in the heart of the Touraine appellation, Domaine Beauséjour lies along the slopes of the Cher River across Noyers-sur-Cher and Saint-Romain-sur-Cher.

The 20-hectare estate was cultivated for five generations by the Trotignon family before being acquired in 2022 by Arnaud and Sibylle Lechat, who continue to guide the domaine with a focus on quality and continuity.

## The People

Arnaud and Sibylle Lechat are the current stewards of Domaine Beauséjour. Their decision to acquire the estate was driven by a desire to work as a family in close connection with the rhythms of nature, an ethos that informs their approach to both vineyard and cellar.

## The Terroir

Vineyards are planted along the slopes of the Cher River across Noyers-sur-Cher and Saint-Romain-sur-Cher, where a mix of clay-limestone and sandy, flinty soils defines the landscape.

Parcel-specific sites include sandy soils over clay with flint (argile à silex), contributing to wines with freshness, aromatic lift, and subtle mineral character.

## Farming & Philosophy

The estate is farmed with a sustainable, reasoned approach, including natural grass cover and controlled yields to maintain vine balance.

In the cellar, fermentations are conducted at low temperatures, with élevage primarily in tank to preserve freshness, purity, and varietal character. The winery, expanded in 2004, supports a balance of traditional practices and modern precision.

**the wines** Domaine Beauséjour produces a focused range of wines that highlight the freshness and accessibility of Touraine.

### Les Grenettes

Sauvignon Blanc with bright citrus, fresh fruit, and a clean, vibrant finish.

### Les Fossiles

A Gamay-based blend with a small proportion of Cot, offering red fruit, soft texture, and easy drinkability.
