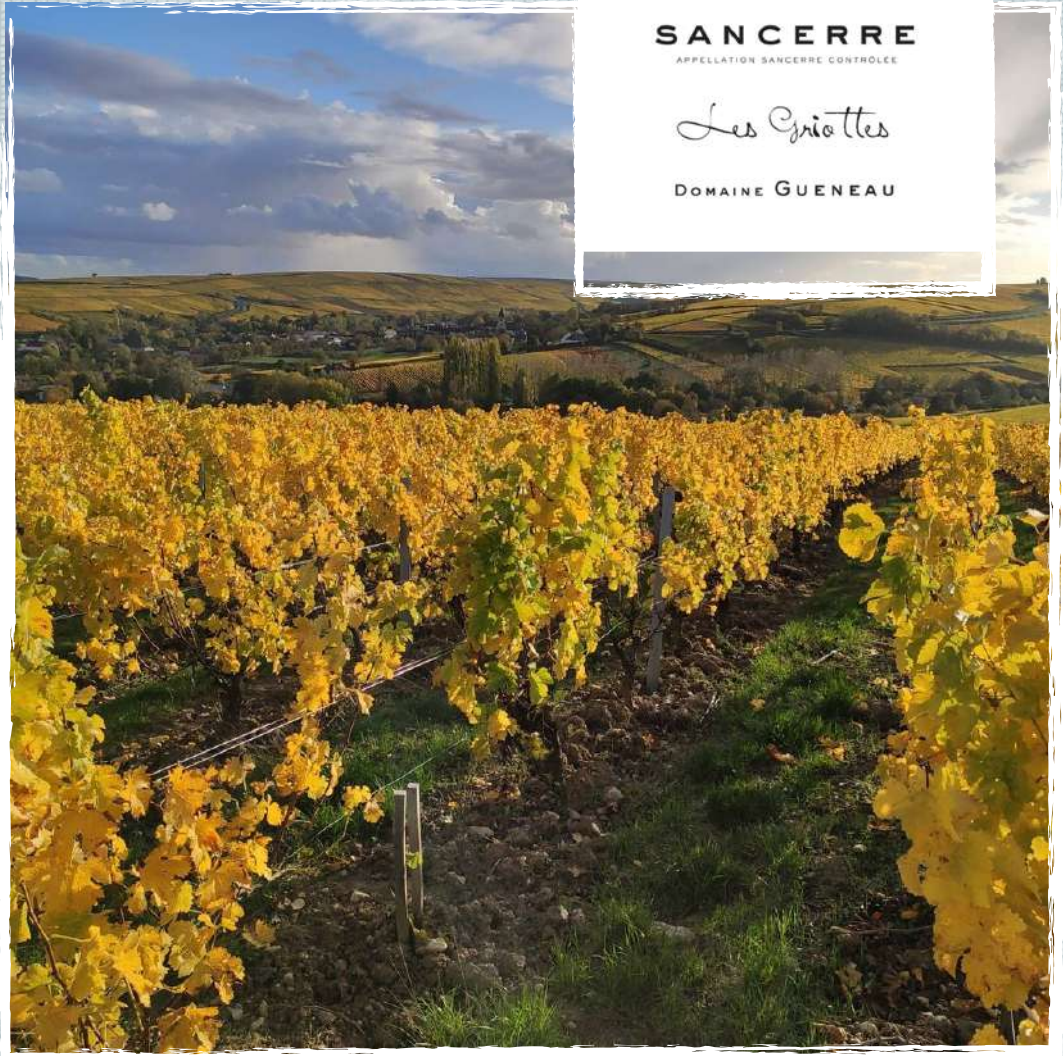

Blend: 100% Sauvignon Blanc

Terroir: 35 year old vines growing on caillottes soils, decomposed limestone broken into pebbles

Elevation: 740 feet

Farming: Sustainable farming

Aging: 8 months in stainless steel tanks, on its lees

Bottled: At the estate

Tasting notes

This small-production wine comes from a single 30+ year-old vineyard on caillottes soils in the village of Chavignol, one of the finest terroirs in Sancerre. Bright and crisp, with aromas of citrus, white peach, apricot, and green apple. The lively palate is strongly reminiscent of the beautiful nose and is shot through with chalky minerality and a mischievous acidity that both help to prolong the lingering, citrusy finish.

Enjoy by itself or with all your seafood dishes over the next three to five years.
