Blend: 60% Grenache, 40% Syrah

Terroir: Located in the town of Bellegarde, between Nîmes and Arles, the terroir is composed of sandstone cobbles in the soil, providing optimal grape ripening which eventually allows Vianney to produce some of the greatest Phone Valley wines.

Elevation: 400 feet

Farming: Sustainable farming

Aging: 6 months in stainless steel tanks

Bottled: At the winery

Tasting notes

The former hunting grounds of Saint-Louis de France, the terroir of Chateau Saint-Louis is made up of rounded galet stones which allow maturation conditions similar to the greatest Cru in the Rhone Valley. The color is pale pink with a fuchsia hue. The nose is complex, with aromas of wild strawberry, cherry, and raspberry. The palate is generous and harmonious, enlivened by ripe and persistent notes of raspberry.

Enjoy chilled over the next 2 years with all your summer meals or by itself with good friends.
