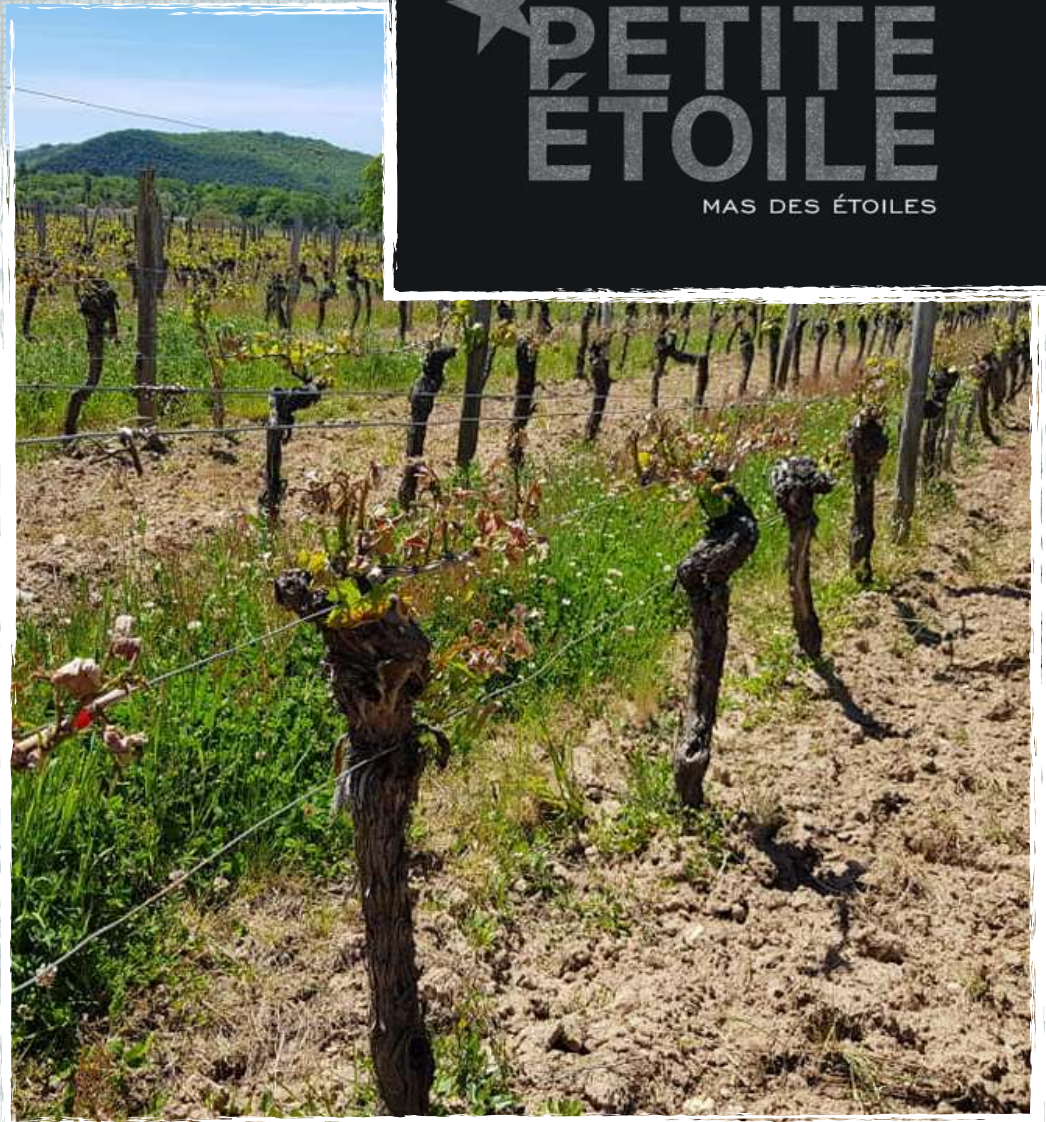

Blend: 100% Malbec

Terroir: 25 year old vines growing on the second terrace on graves, silica, and clayish soils.

Elevation: 300 feet

Farming: Sustainably farmed

Aging: 18 months in stainless steel tanks, on its lees

Bottled: At the estate

Tasting notes

With an intense nose of ripe, juicy red and dark fruits, and a touch of freshly dug earth, ecologically conscious Arnaud Bladinières and his 30-year-old Malbec vines take Cahors into the present day while preserving its classic roots. The round, very fruity palate has a solid structure but very soft, well-integrated tannins from a year and a half worth of aging.

A great modern Malbec from Cahors, that will pair well with all your meats and heartier dishes.
