ROSÉ "CUVÉE ANNA", ŠTAJERSKA

**Blend:** 50% Žametna Črnina [zhá-met-na ch-r-ní-na], 20% Pinot Noir, 20% Pinot Grigio, 10% Blaufränkisch  
**Terroir:** Sandy to rich in marl with vines between 20-55 years old.  
**Low yield;** all pruned to a single guyot.  
**Elevation:** 820-1300 feet  
**Farming:** Organic and natural farming  
**Aging:** 3 months on fine lees  
**Bottled:** At the winery



## Tasting notes

Named after Peter's grandmother, *Cuvée Anna* is ripe with aromas of wild berries, strawberries, melon, and peach. On the palate, very fruity with a lively, refreshing finish. A bright Provence style rosé with the inimitable cool mineral snap and high-toned aromatics of northeast Slovenia.

**Fun fact:** Žametna črnina [zhá-met-na ch-r-ní-na] is the oldest living vine in the world (at 375-400 years old) and it's traditionally planted in Slovenia.
