With only 3.5 hectares of meticulously cared-for vineyards, Numa's wines are a true expression of Burgundy's terroir—vibrant, pure, and with an unmistakable sense of place. By embracing sustainable practices, using minimal intervention in the cellar, and working with indigenous yeasts, Numa produces wines that offer a rare balance of tradition, innovation, and authenticity.
